Why I Believe the Bible - 1

Why do I choose to believe in the Bible as the authoritative Word of God? That's a question we all need to be able to answer. Over the next few bulletin articles, I'm going to tell you why I trust the Bible is from God. Before I give the first reason, understand this is a matter of faith. There is no empirical evidence. In other words, I didn't witness God type pages of the Bible or listen to Him as He dictated each book to their respective authors. There is no tangible evidence that is beyond the shadow of any doubt proving the Bible as the Word of God. It is a matter of faith. It's not a leap in the dark. It's not a ridiculous unwarranted belief. There is ample evidence that supports my faith in the Bible as the Word of God. Hebrews 11:6 says, "And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him."

The first reason I believe the Bible is the authoritative Word of God is because I was taught the Bible is the authoritative Word of God. I was raised in the Church. I'm very thankful that my family attended a local Church that had a very high view of Scripture. Our preacher taught from the Bible. When we had guest speakers, they taught from the Bible. From a very early age, I can remember attending Bible class every Sunday morning and Wednesday night. On Sunday nights during the summer, I attended Bible hour. I went to Vacation Bible School every summer. I don't remember all my Bible class teachers, but the teachers I do remember, did a great job of teaching from the Bible and emphasizing the Bible as the Word of God. It's so important that we have trained and qualified Bible class teachers that that teach Bible lessons from the Bible. We must teach our children starting in cradle roll what the Bible is and its purpose.

Paul says, "faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ" (Rom. 10:17). God's word is truth (John 17:17). All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable (2 Tim. 3:16). "The law of the LORD is perfect . . . His testimony is sure . . . His precepts are right . . . His commandments are pure . . . His decrees are true. More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward" (Psalm 19:7-11).

I'm so thankful God has graciously given us His Word. May we read it, study it, and apply it to our lives.
