Examining Your Bible Reading

It's good to occasionally examine your Bible reading habits. There are parts of the Bible that are difficult to understand and not as enjoyable to read. It's easy to pick up your Bible, read, and before you know it, you lost track of time. It's also easy to wake up, get busy, and before you know it, you lost track of time and forgot to read your Bible. Bible reading and Bible study are so important in life. There are so many benefits, aside from the spiritual, that come from reading your Bible. The primary reason we read the Bible is to know God and understand His will. We want to understand who God is. We want to know what is right and what is wrong. Sometimes that's where Bible reading stops. We read for knowledge and at the end of our daily Bible reading we simply know more. As the old G.I. Joe adage goes, "Knowing is half the battle." Here's another tip for your Bible reading.

- Let your Bible read you!

James wrote, “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing” (James 1:22-25).

James admonishes us, “Don’t just read the word, DO WHAT IT SAYS!” In other words, while you read your Bible, let your Bible read you. Allow the Word of God to shape your thoughts, your words, and your actions. Let your Bible convict you and condition your heart so that you willingly make changes for your good and look more like Jesus. When you read your Bible, God is telling you and teaching you. Every time you read your Bible, the Spirit is holding up a mirror, not for you to look at with your eyes, but for your heart. He doesn’t want you to be a reader who forgets. He wants you to have a heart that does.

Let your Bible read you!
