We Belong To Jesus

Carey Nieuwhof is a bestselling author, speaker, former attorney, and he hosts one of the most influential leadership podcasts. His podcast, blog, and online content for leaders are accessed over 1.5 million times each month. Some of what he does is targeted at church leaders to help with church growth. I receive a weekly email from him and I usually skim through it to see if there's anything that would be beneficial. The other week, his article was titled, "Church Name Ideas: 6 Tips for Naming (or Rebranding) Your Church." The title caught my attention and so I read through it because I've never seen anyone give tips for naming a Church. Here are his 6 tips for name or rebranding a Church.

- 1. Start with a team, not with a denominational meeting. (The idea is to get the least amount of people involved.)
- 2. Focus on who you want to reach.
- 3. Jumpstart your brainstorming with A.I.
- 4. Pick a name that will stand out (especially online).
- 5. Don't get too trendy.
- 6. Think local.

It may or may not surprise you that the article had zero spiritual content. The Bible was not referenced and the need for prayer was vaguely mentioned three times. I was a little surprised and little not surprised. The Church as described in the New Testament isn't a business that needs rebranding to boost sales. The Church is the kingdom of God on earth (Mark 9:1; Col. 1:13) that was established on the day of Pentecost after the resurrection and ascension of Jesus (Acts 2). The Church is the bride of Christ (Eph. 5:22-33; Rev. 19:7) and belongs to Him (Matt. 16:18). Any name worn by Jesus' Church needs to show that we belong to Jesus. We wear the name or better yet, the description, "Church of Christ" because it's a description used in the New Testament (Rom. 16:16) and it shows that we belong to Christ. We want to be the church that belongs to Christ. Instead of starting with a team or brainstorming with A.I., let's open God's word and see what He tells us about who He wants us to be. Jesus wants us to be the pillar and support of the truth (1 Tim. 3:15) that loves God with all our heart, soul, and mind, and loves others as our self (Matt. 22:34-40).
