### **God Is Faithful**

"I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge—even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you—so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord" (1 Corinthians 1:4-9).

When most Christians hear 1 Corinthians or the Church at Corinth mentioned in a Bible class, their minds immediately think of all the problems in that Church. The Church at Corinth certainly had more than their fair share of problems; divisions, sexual immorality, lawsuits, idolatry, abuse of the Lord's Supper, fighting over spiritual gifts, disorder in worship, and some even doubted the resurrection. If we had a "Corinth Church" down the road, we would likely blacklist them as an illegitimate Church due to their seemingly unfaithfulness to Jesus! Paul does admonish them to change their behavior, reminds them they were washed, they were sanctified and they were justified by the authority of Jesus and calls them saints. Despite their spiritual problems and sinful attitudes, Paul tells them in 1:8, Jesus "will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ." Paul tells the problematic Church in Corinth that God will not stop giving the Corinthians His good gifts. God will not stop sustaining them, keeping them going, holding them together. They will remain guiltless or blameless in His eves all the way to the return of Christ on the day of the Lord. How is this even possible? Paul reminds them of who God is, "God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Sin, Jesus Christ our Lord." The grace, mercy, and love of our Father is far more powerful and capable than we can imagine. I pray that we can find rest and satisfaction and comfort in the faithfulness of our God.
