Peter and Prayer

1 Peter is wonderful little book. It's easy to read, consisting of only 5 chapters. Peter addresses several different things. He writes about the living hope we have in Jesus. He calls us to be holy. He addresses the marriage relationship, suffering as a Christian, and he encourages shepherds to care for the sheep. The topic of prayer is not a main theme but it is mentioned 3 times within the letter, and what Peter says about prayer is very important and deserves our attention. Listen to what the Spirit says.

- "Likewise, husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way, showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel, since they are heirs with you of the grace of life, so that your prayers may not be hindered" (1 Peter 3:7).
- "For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their prayer. But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil" (1 Peter 3:12).
- "The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers" (1 Peter 4:7).

Through Peter, the Spirit of God reveals that our prayer life is very dependent on our attitude and manner of life. You may say, "Well that's a no-brainer" and you would be right. But I find it intriguing the way we chose to live can impede our prayers from reaching God's ears or can expedite our prayers. Peter says the prayers of a husband can be blocked from God if he doesn't live in a right relationship with his wife. Wives, your prayers can be hindered as well. The way I approach my marriage is a big deal to God. Failing to exhibit self-control and living a sober life will inhibit your prayer life. WHY? Because God's ears are open to the prayers of the righteous. God listens and takes into consideration the prayers of his faithful children. That's a big deal and ought to cause us to reflect on our lives. Prayer is one side of the relationship I have with God. Prayer is critical to my relationship with God. Be a godly spouse, pursue righteousness, and live in self-control and your prayers will be heard by your heavenly Father.

QUESTION: What aspects of our life do you need to change so that your prayers are not cut off from the ears of God?
