Am I In Or Out?

Sin is rebellion against God and it deserves the death penalty (Rom. 6:23); but forgiveness, redemption, and eternal life are found in Jesus (Eph. 1:7; Rom. 6:23). Thanks be to God for His inexpressible gift (2 Cor. 9:15). There are some who subscribe to the idea that we can't "really know" we are saved until Iesus returns and we stand before him with sweat on our brow and fingers crossed, anxiously waiting to hear the words, "Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master" (Matt. 25:21). Once we hear those words, then we know "we got it right!" That kind of theology is based on OUR ability to stay in between the lines. That's a fearful way to live. There's no assurance or confidence in that kind of faith; only fear, confusion, and uncertainty. John writes, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:13). Our salvation in Jesus isn't wishful thinking.

Chris McCurley wrote, "Sadly, in our efforts to deny the "once saved, always saved" doctrine we sometimes give the impression that a Christian is constantly teetering between heaven and hell—one minute your saved, the next minute you're not. Our security in Christ is constantly wavering. As a result, we live life in perpetual fear—I hope I don't die before I have the chance to repent! I have a bad thought—'Oh, I'm out.' Then I repent, 'Now I'm back in.' I say a bad word, 'Oh, I'm out again.' I repent, 'Ok, I'm back in.' Folks, if that's how it is, then there is no such thing as assurance of salvation."

John writes, "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 Jn. 1:7). Walking in the light gives us assurance. Later in the same letter, John makes a contrast between those who "practice righteousness" and those who "make a practice of sinning." There's a huge difference between a condemned sinner (who practices sin) and a forgiven saint (who practices righteousness but still struggles with sin). Let me illustrate. Imagine two different people with the same black and white picture of a butterfly. They are both given a box of crayons and told to color the butterfly. The first person begins to hastily and carelessly color the butterfly without concern they are doing a sloppy job and coloring outside the lines. The second person carefully and thoughtfully begins to color the butterfly using a variety of vibrant and beautiful colors, very mindful to stay in the lines but occasionally strays outside the lines in a few

Chris McCurley continues, "Christians have an assurance policy. It's underwritten by God. Jesus paid the premium. You will not be denied, even though you have a pre-existing condition. You have full coverage. So, revel in your salvation KNOWING that this life is going somewhere!"

Christians will still struggle with sin as we walk in the light. Let's find assurance and peace in the fact Jesus has saved us completely and wholly (Heb. 7:25).
