Helping Our Kids View The Church As Essential

e New Testament makes it clear the Church that belongs to Jesus is sential to the spiritual well-being of every believer. It's through the urch that we fulfill all the "one another" passages. In the Church (but not vays in worship) we love, admonish, instruct, forgive, edify, and courage one another. The Church is the household/family of God (1 nothy 3:15). The Church is essential, because the Church is the group of ople that Jesus is coming back to save (Ephesians 5:23). So how do we p our children to grow up loving the Church and see her as essential to lowing Jesus?

1.We (parents, grandparents, mentors, other adults) must view the Church as essential and treat her that way. We must make Jesus and His Church THE priority in our life. If our children observe us dismissing Church assemblies when something "more important" or "more fun" pops up, or if we choose to miss assemblies because it's just easier to stay home, we can't be surprised when our children treat the Church the same way. As mature Christians, we must show our children through our actions just how valuable the family of God is to us and how much Jesus loves her.

2.We (parents, grandparents, mentors, other adults) must speak about the Church in a positive and favorable way. Is the Church perfect? Not even close because you and I are part of the Church. If we routinely criticize the Church, our words are teaching our children the Church is a group of people that do nothing but irritate us. Let's show a spirit of wisdom and discernment with our words and talk about the beauty of the Church. Let's promote the Church with our words and love her the way Jesus loves her. After all, WE are part of the family.

3.Trust the Spirit of God to work. After parenting for 19 ½ years, I've accepted the fact that I don't always get it right. I've also learned it's easy to put too much trust in myself and not much trust in the Spirit of God to work. As parents, we need to let God work in the lives of our kids to cultivate the fruit of the Spirit. As we show our kids how to love the LORD and His Church, let's pray and ask the LORD to help our children to love Him, His word, and His people. Let's make sure when we pray for our kids that those prayers are saturate with spiritual content.

t's prioritize the Church as essential in our lives and speak well of her. She the bride of Christ. Let's do everything we can to help our kids fall in love th Jesus and His Church. Let's seek first the kingdom of God and His hteousness (Matthew 6:33).
