## Zaphenath-paneah and his brothers

Sibling rivalry had its beginning with Cain and Abel and it has been causing problems in families ever since. In Genesis 37, we are introduced to 11 brothers who despised one of their younger brothers, Joseph. Joseph had a dream that his family would one day bow down to him. This enraged his brothers, they sell him into slavery, and then tell their father a wild animal killed him. Joseph becomes a slave, is accused of rape, and thrown into prison. In Genesis 41, God gives Joseph the ability to interpret Pharaoh's dream of the seven plump cows and the seven thin cows and the seven plump ears of corn and the seven thin ears of corn. Joseph told Pharaoh there would be seven years of abundant harvest followed by seven years of extreme famine. Joseph also suggests how to solve the problems that would result from seven years of famine. This pleased Pharaoh and Joseph was set over all the land of Egypt, second only to Pharaoh, and was given the name Zaphenath-paneah or "one who discovers hidden things."

During the seven years of famine, Joseph's brothers visited Egypt looking for food and found themselves unknowingly bowing before Joseph just like his dream revealed. Remember Genesis 37? Well, Joseph has a little fun with his brothers and accuses them of being spies. He tests their honesty and asks them to bring back their younger brother Benjamin. Israel moves his entire family to Egypt and is reunited with his son Joseph and meets two grandsons, he didn't know he had.

For 13 years, Joseph's life was turned upside down and he endured some evil and unjust circumstances. I would guess there were times when Joseph asked God "Why?" At the end Genesis, Joseph speaks to his brothers and says, "Do not fear, for am I in the place of God? As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today." (Genesis 50:19,20). Joseph isn't saying that what happened to him in the past 13 years was good. He means, that God worked through all the unjust things that Joseph endured to bring about a good thing; numerous people were kept alive. God's promise to Abraham was kept because He used the evil actions of others to get Joseph were He needed him to be, in Egypt. It's impossible to look ahead in times of distress and see where God is taking us, but I can remain faithful to God, trust Him, and glorify Him in the moment.
