The Greatest Truth

I admire Paul's passion, his determination, his fierce loyalty, his ability to teach, and his love for the Lord and the Church. But most of all, I am so amazed by his complete surrender to Jesus! Before Jesus, Paul is quick to admit he slandered the name of Jesus, hunted down Christians, and sought to destroy the Church. But God was merciful and gracious, and His faithfulness and love abounded toward Paul. (Sounds a lot like Exodus 34:6.) As Paul contemplated his life and looked back, he could say with great confidence and greater appreciation the greatest truth in the world, "The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost." I would cherish the opportunity to sit down with Paul and discuss his transformation. I imagine he had his own life in mind when he wrote, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect" (Romans 12:2).

Paul was able to sit down and write: this is who I was before Jesus and this is who I am now in Jesus. I encourage you to take some time this week to meditate on your life before Jesus and your life after Jesus. Are you growing? Do you still need to allow the Spirit of God to make some big changes? Have you fully surrendered your life over to God?
