Half-Way

We are almost half-way through 2023! Which means, depending on your reading schedule, we should be half-way through the Bible. How are you doing? No need to worry if the answer is, "Not good!" Whether you are ahead of schedule, right on schedule, or behind schedule, here are some tips for finishing strong.

- 1. Pray. Start every Bible reading time with prayer. Pray for focus and understanding. Pray that God's Spirit will help you fall in love with God's word. Pray for perseverance. When you're done with your reading, pray for the strength to apply God's word and live it out.
- 2.Download a Bible app. A good Bible app will help in several ways. Bible apps can help you track your progress and keep you up to date. Bible apps can also allow you to change up your routine and occasionally listen to the Bible being read. I find that sometimes when I listen to the Bible, I notice things I don't otherwise notice. Fun fact: the Bible was meant to be read out loud and listened to.
- 3. Schedule a designated time to read each day. For some people it helps to have a routine and read your Bible the same time every day. Set an alarm or a reminder that your Bible reading time is in 15 minutes, which allows you time to finish what you're doing, go grab your Bible, and sit down to read.
- 4.Remove distractions. We get distracted very easily. We get texts, emails, and phone calls all day long. Our kids are in constant need. Turn your phone off. Find a quiet place in the house. Read before everyone gets up in the morning or after everyone goes to bed at night. Do what you can to eliminate distractions.
- 5. Find someone who will hold you accountable and you can do the same for them. Ask a friend to occasionally check in and ask you questions like, "What did you reading this week?" "What did you learn this week?" "Are you keeping up with your Bible reading?"

I'm so thankful that our shepherds emphasize daily Bible reading. Knowing, understanding, and applying God's word is the only proper way to live. Peter tells us, "His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence" (2 Peter 1:3). Within the pages of the Bible, we find everything we need to know about God and His will for us. You still have plenty of time to finish reading the Bible this year. I hope the above suggestions will be helpful to get you back on track and finish strong. Have you read your Bible today?
