## How To Listen To The Sermon

I've been preaching for just over 15 years. When I stop and think about it, that seems like a long time but I know there are preachers who have been preaching 50+ years. In the last 15 years, on average, I have prepared and delivered 2 sermons a week (not including Bible classes). If I subtract my vacation time, in 15 years I have prepared and preached approximately 1,500 sermons. I can tell you how I prepare, study, and put my sermons together, but I want to give some thought on how a person ought to listen and receive a sermon. Here are 6 things to do, so that you get the most out of

- 1. **Remember God is speaking.** Although you are listening to the voice of the preacher, if the preacher is opening God's word, then you are listening to the authoritative voice of God. Peter says if anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God (1 Pet. 4:11).
- 2. Make sure the preacher says what the Bible says. Always filter what is being taught through God's word. I'm not saying you should listen with skepticism, but I am encouraging you to "fact check" and make sure that what is being taught is God's truth (Acts 17:11).
- 3. **Receive the message with meekness.** James instructs us to "receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls" (James 1:21). When we listen to God's word, we have to listen with an attitude of humility and meekness, because God knows us better than we know ourself. We want a heart that will receive the word of God and allow it to bear fruit.
- 4. Apply the lesson to yourself, not to the person beside you. It's so easy to see faults in others. It's very difficult to see our own faults and allow the Spirit to work on us. Jesus addresses this idea in the sermon on the mount when He said, "First take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye" (Matt. 7:5).
- 5. **Put the lesson into practice.** James says, "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves" (James 1:22). Allowing instruction from God to go in one ear and out the other is of no value. But a lesson that is received with meekness and eagerness will enter the heart and spill over into application. Jesus says if we don't do what He tell us, then we have no right to call him Lord (Luke 6:46).
- 6. **Prepare your heart before you arrive to worship.** Pray for yourself. Pray for the preacher. Put your mind and heart in the right place to listen and receive God's word.

Listening to a sermon may seem like a passive activity, but receiving the word of God takes effort. If you want to be an active listener, open your Bible, read along, take notes, and prepare yourself to live out God's word. I love preaching, and more specifically, I love preaching for Woodland Oaks! All you make preaching so enjoyable!
