The Words We Use

Our words are powerful and possess the ability to influence others for good or bad! They have the potential to hurt and to heal. How often do you think about the words you use? Our normal way of communication is to speak as our words come to mind. Scripture reveals something a little different. James instructs us, "Be quick to hear and slow to speak" (James 1:19). Solomon wrote, "A fool multiplies words" (Eccl. 10:14). Wisdom teaches us to give thought to what we say before we say it, because our words can't be taken back once they have been uttered. We can't erase our words. We must give thought to our words and be careful how we use them because "the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things. How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire" (James 3:5) and "no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so" (James 3:8-10). As followers of Jesus, we must allow the Spirit of God to control our speech. Here are some biblical principles that should govern the words we use.

- <u>Listen first</u>. "If one gives an answer before he hears, it is his folly and shame" (Prov. 18:13).
- Tell the truth. "Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another" (Eph. 4:25).
- Be kind. "Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you" (Eph. 4:31,23).
- <u>Don't say everything that comes to mind</u>. "Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips" (Ps. 141:3)!
- Let the Spirit of God help you choose your words. "Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person" (Col. 4:6).
- Use your words to honor the LORD. "Oh magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together" (Ps. 34:3). See Ps. 145:1-3.

The words we choose communicate thoughts, ideas, feelings, and desires. May the LORD, help us exercise wisdom and self-control when we speak. "Whoever guards his mouth preserves his life; he who opens wide his lips comes to ruin" (Prov. 13:3). Be careful what you say, because your words reveal your heart. "Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks" (Matt. 12:34).
