The word "profanity" or "profane" is a biblical word. In the Bible, to make something profane is to take what is "holy" and use it in a common way, thus making it "unholy or unclean." According to the law of Moses an Israelite could profane an altar (Ex. 20:25), profane the Sabbath (Ex. 31:14), profane the name of the LORD (Lev. 22:34), and profane God's covenant (Mal. 2:10).

Under the new covenant, a follower of Jesus can become guilty of profaning the blood of Jesus by which we are sanctified (Heb. 10:29) when they continue to willfully sin (Heb. 10:26) instead of allowing the Spirit of God to transform them. When we profane the blood of Jesus, forgiveness is unavailable, and we outrage the Spirit of grace (Read Heb. 10:19-31). Although, the word "profane" or "profanity" is not used in the Bible to describe words, we can use profane speech. The NT uses words like "corrupt, obscene, and filthy" to describe profane speech. Consider Paul's instructions to Christians about how to use our words.

The NT teaches us to use our words in a way that builds up, expresses thanks, imparts grace, and that sets a proper example and reflection of Jesus. Our words are to be chosen carefully and be well placed. That gives a broader meaning to what should be considered profanity to Christians. Profanity then isn't limited to a group of four-letter words or words that are considered filthy and obscene. Profanity would include words spoken for the purpose of malice, slander, and gossip. James tells us, the tongue "is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so" (James 3:8-10). Jesus said, "Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks" (Matt. 12:34), and "it is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but what comes out of the mouth; this defiles a person" (Matt. 15:10,11). Our words give others a direct and unfiltered glimpse into our heart. Be careful little mouth what you say!

Christians and Profanity

Letters are a fundamental building block of language. Letters are put together, to form sounds that are called words. Each word has a unique meaning attached to it that expresses our thoughts, feelings, and knowledge. Words are not inherently evil or profane, but there is a class of words we call "profanity." Profanity is "blasphemous or obscene" language also known as cursing, swearing, or foul language. Profanity is socially offensive words.

• "Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear" (Eph. 4:29).

• "Let there be no filthiness nor foolish talk nor crude joking, which are out of place, *but instead let there be thanksgiving*" (Eph. 5:4).

• "But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth" (Col. 3:8).

• "Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person" (Col. 4:6).

• "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity" (1 Tim. 4:12).
