### **Using God's Name in Vain**

The Bible is the self-revelation of God to humanity. Creation reveals His creative power and ability, but Scripture reveals His nature, character, and His name. In Exodus 3, God speaks to Moses and reveals His proper name, YHWH. Yahweh is built on the verb "I am" and signifies God's absolute being. Yahweh (I Am Who I Am or I Will Be Who I Will Be) has no beginning, no ending, no dependance on anything or anyone outside of Himself. He is supremely sovereign. God's name is a description of His reality. He is totally and completely self-existent; He is sovereign. In Exodus 20, the Israelites have agreed to enter a covenant with the LORD (Yahweh). He says, "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself a carved image . . . You shall not take the name of Yahweh your God in vain, for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain" (Ex. 20:1-7). The command is clear, do not take the LORD's name in vain. All though the same command is not restated in the NT, the principle is clear; we are to honor God's name and give Him glory because He is holy!

- "Our Father in heaven, hollowed be your name" (Matt. 6:9).
- "To the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen" (1 Tim. 1:17).
- "Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created" (Rev. 4:11).
- "Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! Amen" (Rev. 7:12).
- "Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy" (Rev. 15:4).

Let God's word impress upon you, that GOD (or any of His names in Scripture) is not a throw away word! It's not an empty word to be used when we are surprised, excited, amazed, shocked, angry, or wanting to emphasize our emotion. OMG isn't an exclamation to be used over an amazing bargain. Jesus Christ is the Savior of the world who died to give you life; He's not a phrase of disgust or frustration. Using God's name in vain means to use His name in a way that diminishes His majesty, His holiness, and His glory.

But taking God's name in vain isn't simply an issue of how we use the name of God in our speech. It's weightier than that. As a human, I bear the image of God, but as a Christian, I wear God's name and take Him with me everywhere I go. The issue of "taking" God's name, becomes a matter of how we represent Him to the world (see Eph. 4:22-5:10). If I call myself a child of God, but I'm not living in holiness, I am guilty of taking his name in vain!
