She found herself working in a field belonging to Boaz.

—Ruth 2:3

You do what you have to do, right?

For Ruth that meant scavenging the fields picking up grain that the harvesters had missed so she and her mother-in-law could eat. "Now she just happened to end up in the portion of the field belonging to Boaz" (NET).

Boaz took a shine to Ruth and married her.

Boaz was the son of Rahab, a Jericho prostitute. Ruth was a Moabitess, a Gentile. Boaz and Ruth had a son named Obed, who had a son named Jesse, who had a son named David.

Yes, that David, King David.

So David's paternal great-great-grandmother was a prostitute, and his maternal great-grandmother was a Gentile. Both were in the lineage of Jesus (see Mt 1:5–6).

God does unlikely things with unlikely people in unlikely circumstances. Look at what happened because Ruth "just happened" to glean in the field of Boaz.
