As I was reading 2 Corinthians last week, there were a couple of verses that really caught my attention. I've read them before but this time, I wrote them down and had to come back to them, reread them, and then do a little research. In 2 Corinthians 8, Paul discusses the generosity of the churches in Macedonia. In verse 16, Paul commends Titus because he has an earnest care for the Corinthian Church and on his own accord Titus wants to come visit them. Then verse 18 caught my attention. Paul wrote, "With him (Titus) we are sending the brother who is famous among all the churches for *his preaching of the gospel.*" The word "famous" means "appropriately commended." Other translations uses words like, "praised," "fame," and "highly respected." Paul tells the Corinthian Church he's sending a "celebrity preacher" to them. It's hard to imagine someone more wellknown than Paul. This verse raises a couple of questions.

We know from 1 Corinthians 1:10-12, the Corinthian Church had a problem with division in Church caused by different people "attaching" themselves to a few different "celebrity preachers." Some were saying, "I follow Paul" or "I follow Apollos," or "I follow Cephas," or "I follow Christ." Paul reminds them, Christ isn't divided, Jesus died for you, and you were immersed in the name of Jesus. Perhaps Paul didn't mention this "famous brother" by name as a tool of humility for both the preacher and the Corinthians. It's easy to let fame and popularity to get in the way of Jesus and the gospel. Remember, Jesus is our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30). Let's determine as Paul, "For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified" (1 Cor. 2:2).

1. Who is this famous brother? We don't know who this brother is. Paul wrote 2 Corinthians during his third missionary journey. During his 3<sup>rd</sup> missionary journey, Paul had several traveling companions such as, Luke, Timothy, Sopater Aristarchus, Secundus, Gaius, Tychicus, and Trophimus (Acts 20:4). Some think it could have been Luke, Apollos, Barnabas, Silas, Timothy, or Mark. The famous preacher could have been any of the above but the fact is, we just don't know who it Paul is talking about, but the Corinthians

2. Why didn't Paul mention his name? It is strange that Paul didn't mention this brother's name. Paul had no problems mentioning his travel companions. Obviously, the man needed no introduction. Maybe he was instrumental in the lives of the Corinthians. Maybe mentioning his name would have put him at risk. Whatever the reason, we simply don't know who he is and we don't know why Paul left out his name.
