God is Faithful

"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you—so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord" (1 Corinthians 1:3-9).

According to Paul's letter to the Church in Corinth, the local Church there was dealing with several different spiritual problems:

- There were divisions (1:10ff).
- They weren't spiritual minded (3:1ff).
- There was sexual immorality in the church (5:1ff).
- They were taking each other to court (6:1ff).
- They were abusing the Lord's Supper (11:17ff).
- They were arguing about who had the better spiritual gifts (12:1ff).
- Some doubted Jesus has been resurrected (15:1ff).

Each of these is a serious problem of its own, but to have all these problems present in one local Church happening at the same time, that's hard to imagine. Their church assemblies must have been very stressful, tense and very self-focused, instead of encouraging, uplifting, and Christ-centered. Yet Paul calls them "the church of God" "sanctified in Christ" and "called to be saints" (1:2). They were still "in Christ" and he was going to sustain them to the end and keep them guiltless. Jesus possessed the power to keep them secure and innocent in the midst of their worst spiritual struggles. God is absolutely faithful to His children. I'm so thankful for such a merciful, loving, and faithful Father in heaven. Spend some time this week in prayer, thanking God for His constant faithfulness! God is good!
