A formula is a statement intended to express a fundamental truth or principle. It is an effort to express a [sometimes] difficult principle in its simplest form. However, in order for a formula to be of value, it must both adequately and accurately express the truth it represents.

While that certainly represents progress toward more accurately and adequately expressing what the Bible says about how we are saved, believe it or not ... we're not through yet!

Our formula now says that grace accomplishes some portion of my salvation and I (through my faith) accomplish some portion of it. That's still not what the Bible says. My bible says, "Salvation is by grace **through** faith." That's not the same as saying "Salvation is by grace **plus** faith!"

So, an accurate formula is "Grace = Salvation". Jesus did everything to make salvation available. You can't do anything to add to it. Consequently, righteousness is "imputed". It is offered as a gift. You receive it through your (obedient) faith. Cf. Romans 5:2.

#### **Imputed Righteousness**

Does the following formula represent your understanding of how a person is saved: Grace + Faith + Works = Salvation?

My first question is, "What does the Bible say faith plus works equals?" Answer: "complete faith." See James 2:22. So, when we use the term "faith" as the Bible defines it, it includes "works". Therefore, we can take "works" out of our formula (since it is inherently part of faith). Now our formula more accurately reads "Grace + Faith = Salvation".

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God- not by works, so that no one can *boast."* - Ephesians 2:8-9

Brothers and sisters, if we are going to use a formula, let's make absolutely sure that it accurately and adequately expresses what the Bible says. Close is not good enough!
