We need to commit ourselves the to local Church. Don't simply show up, check a few boxes, go through the motions, and then come back at the next appointed time. Commit yourself to the local Church. Be an active member. Church membership (committing yourself to a local Church) isn't man's idea. It is assumed throughout the NT. It's a given. Some would say, "Well I'm a member of the universal Church. I don't need to 'place membership' at a local congregation." Yes, every Christian is a member of the Church. The above Scripture tells us the Lord adds people to His Church, but the NT assumes each Christian will identify and commit themselves to a local congregation where they can serve and grow. Consider these verses:



Volume XXXI—Issue 41

The LORD Adds To His Church

"And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved" (Acts 2:46,47).

• *"Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your"* souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you" (Hebrews 13:17). The Spirit of God has set in place leaders in the local Church to shepherd souls. Each member is function in a way that causes them to lead with joy! You can't do that unless you are committed to a local congregation.

• "Let a widow be enrolled if she is not less than sixty years of age, having been the wife of one husband, and having a reputation for good works: if she has brought up children, has shown hospitality, has washed the feet of the saints, has cared for the afflicted, and has devoted herself to every good work" (1 Timothy 5:9,10). Membership is assumed in the care of the Church. Widows can't be properly enrolled and cared for without some kind of Church membership list.

• "It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife. And you are arrogant! Ought you not rather to mourn? Let him who has done this be removed from among you" (1 Corinthians 5:1,2). Without membership, how do we practice discipline in the Church?

• "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near" (Hebrews 10:24,25). Local membership is assumed in all the one-another passages. Without local Church membership, this doesn't make any sense.

No one can add themselves to the body of the saved! Jesus saves us and places us in His Church. At that point, we need to commit ourselves to the local Church so we can grow, encourage, and serve. I am so thankful for the local Church that is Woodland Oaks. She is so special to me and my family, and I trust she is special to you as well.
