God Loves The Church

I think Paul's letter to the Ephesians is one of the most beautiful letters ever written. I love Paul's use of language. I appreciate his words, phrases, and encouragements. Even more, I love the way Paul speaks of the Church. Paul uses several significant images to describe the Church. He refers to the Church as God's workmanship (2:10), one new man (2:15), the household of God (2:19), a holy temple (2:21), and a body (4:4,12). Each of those is packed with rich meaning. Paul begins this letter an outburst of praise to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (1:3). Within his praise to God, Paul describes the Church with phrases that illustrate God's strong love and commitment to His Church.

• Blessed in Christ (v3)

• Chosen before the foundation of the world (v4)

• Holy and blameless (v4).

• Predestined (v5)

• Adopted as sons through Jesus Christ (v5).

• Redeemed through the blood of Jesus (v7).

• Lavished with the riches of grace (v7,8)

• Given an inheritance (v11)

• Sealed with the promised Holy Spirit (v13).

From the first chapter of Ephesians, we get a Spirit centered definition of the Church. The Church is a predestined group, chosen before the creation of the world, who are holy and blameless adopted sons, redeemed by the blood of Jesus, lavished with grace, and sealed with the Holy Spirit who is the guarantee of their inheritance. Wow, what a beautiful image of the Church. After reading Ephesians there is no doubt that God is committed to and loves His Church. The declarations of Paul about the people of God should really cause us to stop and evaluate our own love and commitment to the Church!
