Not Another Genealogy!

your Bible reading you've probably made the above statement re than once. There are numerous genealogies in the Old stament. They are difficult and unenjoyable to read. Welcome to New Testament. The first thing Matthew does is test your owledge of the Old Testament with none other than a genealogy! e book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of raham" (Matt. 1:1). This is Matthew's way of not only introducing to Jesus, but he's also showing us that Jesus is the fulfillment of the mises made to Abraham and David.

The LORD promised Abraham, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed" (Gen. 12:1-3). See also Galatians 3:16. By connecting Jesus to Abraham, Matthew is bringing our attention back to the above promise. Matthew wants us to see that Jesus is the long-awaited son of Abraham who will bring God's blessings onto all humanity. How will Jesus do that? Let's look at the promise made to David.

The LORD promised David, "When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of *his kingdom forever*" (2 Sam. 7:12,13). This promise draws our attention to the royal line of King David. Matthew reveals that Jesus is royalty. Through King Solomon, Jesus is the rightful heir to the throne of David's kingdom that will be established forever.

tthew has put something very unique in his genealogy. Matthew included four women: Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, and Bathsheba, These men are either non-Israelites or connected to a sex scandal. tthew shows us in his genealogy that 1) Jesus is the son of raham who will bring blessings to the whole world, 2) He's the val son of David whose kingdom will be established forever, and 3) d has been using all types of people to move His plan forward.
