Knowledge Is NotWisdom

"There are two sides to every story." Sometimes three. Actually there are usually as many sides as there are people involved.

So, an enlightened person will reserve judgment until he hears all sides, right? Solomon says, "The first to present his case seems right, till another comes forward and questions him." Proverbs 18:17. Wisdom dictates that we wait to make a judgment until we have all the facts. Then we are more capable of determining what is true.

As in every matter, there is a danger of the extremes. Some folks fall in love with the investigative process and never reach a determination... like the philosophers in the meeting of the Areopagus (Acts 17). Paul warned Timothy about those whose life was dedicated to "always learning but unable to acknowledge the truth." These men were considered the great, elite minds of the time. They prided themselves in being able to "argue either side"... to "present conflicting evidence" in such an impressive way that anyone who maintained the idea that truth was objective would be considered simple and ignorant. Paul said that such men" oppose the truth."

Do you think it's possible to be so open and tolerant of every idea that we decide that truth cannot be known? When Paul spoke of one God who would judge all mankind, they "sneered" ("made it into a joke").

Learning is a good thing... if you don't rob yourself of the ability to recognize truth.




