Tempest In A Teacup

Y2K. Do you remember what that is? If you’re younger than 25 or so you probably don’t. It was an abbreviation for the year 2000. It came to represent anticipated problems associated with the arrival of the day January 1, 2000.

An oversimplified explanation is that sometime during the 1960-70’s computer programmers in order to save time and space in software programs began to designate years with a 2-digit number rather than a 4-digit number (i.e. 1990 became 90. etc.). The concern was based around the fear that computers systems would fail on Jan. 1, 2000 when there was no 2-digit number beyond 99 (1999). As that deadline approached, concern turned (in some cases) to near-panic. Electric power grids were going to fail putting large cities in darkness; traffic lights were going to shut down causing massive pile-ups; elevators were going to stop between floors; airplanes were going to fall from the sky; banks were going to lose their electronic records, etc.

Lest you think that only “ignorant” people would believe such hype - John Hamre, U.S. Deputy Secretary of Defense, said “The Y2K problem is the electronic equivalent of El Nino and there will be nasty surprises around the globe.” President Bill Clinton signed legislation entitled “Year 2000 information and Readiness Act,” stating “The Y2K problem is an enormous challenge, and we must meet it...”

What do you suppose happened on that fateful day? Nothing. A tempest in a teacup.

This illustrates yet another reason why Christians must focus on Bible reading, study, teaching and preaching rather than the latest fad in religion. In a 1/3/13 article in the New York Times, Mark Oppenheimer, writing about resurgence in Calvinism in American churches writes, “Ten years ago, everyone was talking about the ‘emergent church,’ and five years ago, people were talking about the ‘missional church.’ And now ‘new Calvinism’...”

It’s so easy to lose our focus and get sidetracked. Remember Jesus said, “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.” Mt. 24:35

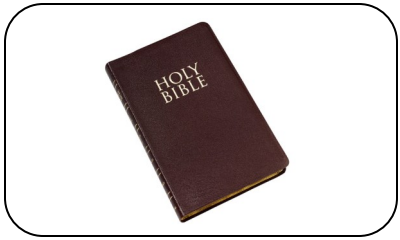
