Written On My Heart

As I read my Bible I come across some phrases that intrigue me. I write some of them down that I think have extra-special meaning. I put it somewhere that I know I'll see it and think about what it means and how I can apply it to my life. I call it "putting it on the back burner" (to let it simmer).

Several months back I was struck with the phrase "I will write it on their hearts." The primary place it is used is Jeremiah 31:33. In the context, God is promising to make a new covenant with his people in future days. In contrasting this new covenant with the one he had made with Israel when they came out of Egypt, he says, "It will not be like (that) covenant ... I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts."

What would be the difference between a law written on stone and a law written on your heart?

I think that a law written on stone is pretty impersonal. It may or may not affect your life much. You may obey it, but your heart doesn't have to be in it. It's ritual. It's habit. You do it because your folks did. Or maybe it carries a severe enough penalty to scare you into obedience. Galatians 3:12 says, "The law is not of faith." You can keep that law without trusting God, you may even resent having to keep it.

But a law that is written on my heart... that's a law that I WANT to keep. You don't have to "show me where it says I have to." I want to! It makes all the difference in the world.

Maybe the most practical way to know if God's word is written on your heart is to ask yourself, "Do I obey God because I feel like I have to, or do I really want to?"





