He Doesn’t Look Like a Predator

When a predator approaches a group of unsuspecting animals, whom does it target? The young, right? Why? Well, I can think of a number of reasons. The young are naturally more inquisitive; they have a lot of unanswered questions about life. The young will take more risks. They have not seen one of their peers dragged away and killed by a predator. They’re not alert to danger. They are not as strong. In short, they’re easy prey.

Just to keep things in perspective of my analogy, the predator is fierce, cunning, merciless and hungry. There is no one, not even the entire group of potential victims who can effectively challenge the power of the enemy. If someone can sense the danger early enough, they can run. But if the group is not alert enough and allows the predator to get too close or even worse, to gain entrance into the group, blood will flow. Somebody you love gets killed.

Have you ever seen a false teacher? Seriously. Have you? He doesn’t at all look like what you would expect. At least not all of them do. He may be the most popular, coolest guy of all. If he wasn’t, he wouldn’t be very effective, would he?

Peter warned the early church about false teachers. He said, “They will secretly come in bringing their self-willed opinions for the purpose of gaining followers.” He warned that many within the church would follow them and consequently the way of truth would come into disrepute.

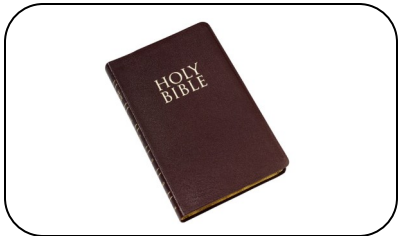
Paul warned the leaders of the church at Ephesus that “savage wolves” would enter the flock after he left and they “would not spare the flock.”
