Old and New

For some years of our life we live by what we were taught by our early teachers – parents, close relatives and teachers at school. Some folks stop there. “That’s good enough for me.” But we likely find some of those theories may have been overly simplistic. Perhaps they were true... as far as they went.

We also discover that not all opinions are equal. Some have been tainted w/ignorance or prejudice.

The standard upon which we base our decisions and live our lives evolves as we grow and mature. Along the way we revise... perhaps even reject some of the things we were taught earlier in our life.

A couple of observations about this process:

#1 – Don’t unnecessarily burn bridges to your past. There might be something back there that you realize you desperately need some day. In case you don’t know it, arrogance burns bridges. Humility builds them.

#2 – Be sure that your “new discovery” is more valuable (and accurate) than what you’re replacing. The prodigal son wasted a great deal of not only his own life and resources, but his father’s as well. His father would have been justified in greeting him with the same words the selfish, rich farmer heard – “You fool...!”

As you form the basis for your life-decisions, there is a valuable principle you would do well to remember - “There is nothing new under the sun.” When you think you have discovered a new truth (if it is in fact true), it’s not new. It just has a new name. So consider God’s admonition: “Do not remove the old landmarks.”

As you build your life, remember – not everything old is bad; not everything new is good... and vice versa.

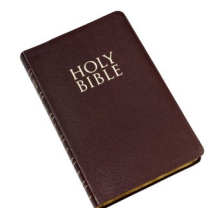

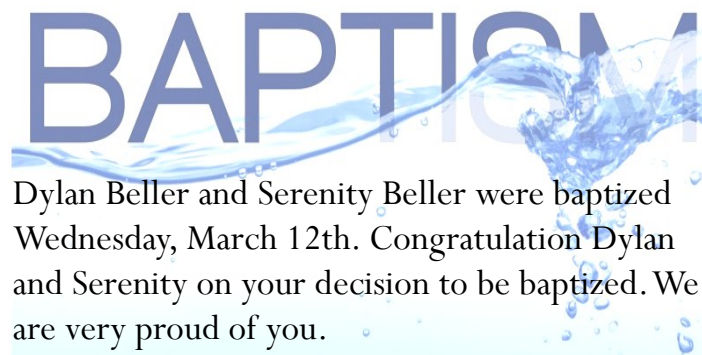
