# Which Pronoun Do You Use?

There are a few decisions that we make in life upon which all other decisions are based. Those decisions determine our morality. They determine our level of commitment and the direction of our life.

The decisions I'm primarily thinking about has to do with how committed you are to the Lord. Lots of folks put off making any real decision that involves an "all-in" commitment. They are kind of like what Josephus said about the Samaritans — [paraphrase] "They claim to be Jews when it is advantageous and to not be Jews when it is expedient."

Here's a practical way to know if you have made an "all-in" commitment to the Lord — when you speak to someone outside the church about the church...which pronoun do you use? Us or them?

John, in his first epistle, says there are two tests which demonstrate whether or not we love God. The first one is "Do you love truth and obey it?" The second one is "Do you love your brethren?"

It's a conscious, reasoned decision to be "all-in." You must decide if it's worth the cost. The cost is not cheap. In fact, it's everything you have. Its' the decision that says "My wife/husband, my children, my money, my time, my job, my resources, my life...they are all God's and I will use them all to glorify him. Nothing is mine; it's all His."

When we make this commitment, most of life's decisions become automatic. If I turn my life over to Him, then nothing can separate me from Him – not even if my life is jeopardized.

From that point on, every decision I make will be based on what God tells me to do.


