Jesus More Popular than Mao

Somewhere in China there are [what is left of] one hundred thousand New Testaments with a front cover that reads, not Holy Bible, but rather International English Textbook. They are bilingual – Chinese and English. They were printed and distributed in China more than twenty years ago. (If you’re interested, ask me about it sometime)

I read an article this past week published by Christian Today that claims that monitoring China’s premier social platform (think “twitter”) shows that, in spite of extremely tight control by the government, Jesus is more popular than Chairman Mao (the “father” of Chinese communism).

It was revealed that Jesus was mentioned in more than 18 million posts, the word Bible was mentioned more than 17 million times, and God received more than 165 million posts. All this in a nation that has been officially atheistic for more than 60 years.

The only legal way to own a bible is through the government-controlled church. Official government figures put the number of Christians at 25 million. But that does not take into account those who are part of the “underground church” whose numbers are estimated at between 60-100 million. Very few of them own a Bible. The few Bibles they have are disassembled and each page is shared for a short time with individual members.

And I’m reminded “God, your word is still as powerful as it ever was. You are the one who controls nations. Though men rage against you – though entire nations rebel against you, they soon return to dust and your word lives on. It still changes hearts and lives. Please let me never forget that you are in control and only you can change the hearts of men.”
