IT IS MY JOB

I thought everyone had heard this, but when I used it in my lesson Sunday evening, several folks wanted a copy of it. So here it is:

That’s Not My Job

This is a story about four people named EVERYBODY, SOMEBODY, ANYBODY and NOBODY. There was an important job to be done and EVERYBODY was sure SOMEBODY would do it. ANYBODY could have done it, but NOBODY did. SOMEBODY got angry about that because it was EVERYBODY’S job. EVERYBODY thought ANYBODY could do it, but NOBODY realized that EVERYBODY wouldn’t do it. It ended up that EVERYBODY blamed SOMEBODY when NOBODY did what ANYBODY could have done.

I can think of any number of applications... I’ll share a couple.

First, Every worthwhile effort requires ONE SOMEBODY to take responsibility to see that it is done consistently and correctly.

The ministries that I have seen be successful in the church have had one person who sees that the job is done every time. If they must be absent, they make all the necessary arrangement to see that the job will be done. They are unwilling to leave anything up to “chance.” They likely have others to whom they have delegated responsibility, but they take personal responsibility to see that the job is done. We have folks like that. I love them.

Second, When you see something that needs doing... do it.

Don’t assume that someone else will do it. Everyone else is assuming the same thing. You NEED to be using your talents to serve the Lord by serving his people. You have not fulfilled your responsibility when you point out something that needs doing! It is a privilege to be allowed to serve alongside Jesus.

Remember, “*For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...*”
