Your Place in God’s Plan

At a news conference some time into the Iraq war, Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld was asked by a reporter about the “apparent failure to follow the war plan.” He responded, “I don’t believe you have the war plan.”

There are times in our lives that circumstances may cause us to question whether or not God is doing his job. We feel that maybe he’s not following the plan. At such times we need to be reminded that it’s not our plan... it’s not even the plan that we have persuaded ourselves that God is supposed to follow. It’s his plan. And he didn’t consult you (or me) when he formulated it.

Job worked himself up into absolute conviction that God wasn’t living up to his part of the bargain because God was not doing anything about his suffering. He repeatedly said, “God, if you would just give me a chance to defend myself and if you would answer me, I know I could prove you are wrong to allow this to happen. You are not following the plan!”

Finally God granted Job’s wish. He answered him. And he said, “Job, where were you when I... [made the plan]?” “Would you discredit my justice? Would you condemn me to justify yourself?” Job repented. He said, “I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted.”

God has a plan. He has had a plan since before the beginning. You fit into that plan. He has a place for you. But the truth is, you may not like your place. Jesus certainly had a place in God’s plan, didn’t he? Would you like to have his place? ... on Golgotha?

As it turned out, Job had a powerful, influential place in God’s plan, didn’t he? He’s still encouraging people today. Jesus had the central role in God’s eternal plan... but it wasn’t easy or pleasant.

So the next time you feel like God’s not following the plan... remember, you know the goal of the plan... but only God knows the plan. And his plan cannot be thwarted. It’s working... whether you can see it or not.
