What Determines Right and Wrong?

The book of Judges warns about moral relativism, or behavior based on human opinions. The Bible teaches that the standards for human behavior are God-given. Left alone, humans will always fail to live up to those standards.

The phrase the Bible uses to characterize the period of the judges is basically true of every era of human existence- "*Every man did that which was right in his own eyes.*" Society establishes standards of behavior based on majority opinion. For those of us who have lived on this earth for a while, we can look back and realize some things that were wrong are now considered to be acceptable and some things that were acceptable a few years ago are now considered wrong.

Morality based on public opinion is capricious. For example, before 1973 abortion was illegal in the United States, implying that it was morally wrong and hurtful to American culture. The famous *Roe v. Wade* decision of the U.S. Supreme Court of that year changed not only the law, but popular attitudes about abortion. It soon changed from being immoral to being considered by many as a basic human right!

What really changed? Did some wrong and sinful action suddenly become acceptable, just because a powerful group decided so? Did the universal truths that previously made abortion illegal suddenly change? No. American society changed! Americans wanted to be able to control the consequences of behavior in which we were determined to engage.

God's moral standards never change. Though societies and cultures inevitably evolve, God's requirements of righteousness never do. Society has the ability to exert extreme pressure on each societal member to bend to its whims; but Christians realize that God has an absolute, timeless standard of holiness that guides our lives.
