Blinded By the Darkness

When I was a boy I spent a week at my Granddaddy and Mamaw's house each summer. They didn't have running water or indoor plumbing. The water wasn't a problem because I thought it was neat to use the hand pump and the gourd dipper at the well, AND... best of all, you only had to take a bath once a week!

However, the lack of indoor plumbing was another matter. Not so bad in the daylight, but the path to the outhouse was fraught with danger in the dark! Bears, lions, snakes, wildcats, panthers—they were all out there . . . waiting. Moonlight helps a little, but the shadows can be even spookier than the dark—especially if the wind is blowing a little bit. You wouldn't believe how many times I barely made it back to the house in a dead, heart-pounding run, one step ahead of whatever-it-was that was chasing me!

The Bible talks about "walking in the light." It indicates that "light" is always available to me if I choose to walk in it. I don't ever have to walk in the dark again. The Bible also indicates that the lion in the darkness of this world is real. And he really is stalking me. But he's only powerful in the darkness; the light robs him of his power because in the light you can see him for what he is. In the darkness, he can conceal himself. We're almost blind in the darkness, but he's not—that's his world.

Darkness represents, among other things, lies and half-truths. Nothing is for sure. You can have your own truth . . . believe what you want to believe.

Jesus said something that strikes me as really bizarre. He said that He came to us who are lost in darkness, with a light—to show us the way home. And he told us that he would walk with us. But we said, "No, I prefer the darkness." See John 3:19.

. . . And, in the darkness, the lion grinned!


