

Don't Judge Me

It's interesting to observe how each generation uses words and phrases in ways that express what is important to that particular generation.

One of the phrases I've noticed that is currently popular is, "Don't judge me." I see and hear sentences beginning with, "Don't judge me, but . . ." We proceed to reveal something that we believe or maybe something we plan to do. Whatever concept or action follows is one that we have reason to know will be met with disapproval. And, we don't want to hear it, so we pre-label any potential negative response as "judgmental." That enables us to dismiss without consideration any response which we don't like.

So anyone who disagrees with us is judgmental.

It occurs to me that (at least in that sense) I do want to be judged . . . admittedly not by just anyone, but by concerned, godly brothers and sisters. Paul charged Timothy, "*Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction.*"

He also tells him what is to be the basis of such judging—"All **scripture** is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking and correcting and training in righteousness." The two actions included in both scriptures are "correcting and rebuking." Inherent within the word "rebuke" is judging; the word "correcting" literally means "to restore to an upright position." So, if we develop an attitude that refuses to accept "being judged," we refuse to allow God and the Holy Spirit to work in our lives.
