Looking Toward the New Year

We had two hundred thirty folks sign up to read our Bibles through in 2014. How many of us followed

Last week I preached the funeral for a lady who had been part of a congregation that started 13 years ago encouraging its members to read through the Bible each year. She was unable to complete the entire Bible this year, but she completed it each year except this one.

There are so many reasons that you should be consistently reading your Bible. One good reason is that it keeps you focused on spiritual matters. If you don't stay focused on God's word, the world is going to eat you alive. I've never known of someone who was studying their Bible regularly who drifted away from the Lord. It's easy to become discouraged when we're not regularly studying God's word. 
