

Learning to Drink Dirty Water

I read a political comment recently that was criticizing the political party which the writer opposed. The comments were critical of people who were [in the writer's words] "unwilling to compromise." The solution he offered was summarized in a quote—"If you don't want to drown, you had better learn to drink dirty water."

Some folks open their mouth and can't close it until they have made themselves look foolish.

The United Nations Development Program reports that nearly two million children around the world die every year because of the lack of clean water.

But it occurs to me that "dirty water" is the only thing this world has to offer—morally. And if you are going to be accepted by the world, you must learn to drink it.

Reminds me of the conversation between the Samaritan woman and Jesus—when she had come to Jacob's well to draw water. The idea behind Jesus' comment about "living water" was based on the concept of fresh, flowing water as opposed to the stagnant water in the well. Samaria had no rivers—except the Jordan on its eastern border. So, almost everyone depended on wells.

The world has learned to drink dirty water, but Jesus offers clean, pure water—not water that makes you sick, but water that gives life.

Don't learn to drink dirty water.


