What Can You Give Away—Yet Not Lose It?

There are, I'm confident, hundreds of thousands of little-known stories from holocaust survivors. Many of the stories tell of the profound effect of a small act.

One such story is told by Francine Christophe. She was eight years old when her mother was arrested and sent to a concentration camp. As a child of a prisoner of war, she was allowed to bring one very small bag to the camp. Her mother chose two pieces of chocolate as the contents. She told her daughter, "I'll keep this for a time when you completely collapse and you really need help. Then I'll give you this and you'll feel better."

After some time, a woman in the camp was having a baby and was so malnourished and in such poor health that neither she nor her baby were expected to live. Francine's mother asked her if she could give the chocolate to the woman. She agreed. Both mother and child survived; however the extremely underweight baby never cried . . . never made a sound.


Fortunately, Francine survived and some years later, having a child of her own, her daughter asked, "Would it have helped you and the other survivors if when you were released, counselors had been available to you?"

Francine decided to organize a lecture on the topic. It was attended by historians, psychologists, psychiatrists, elderly survivors and their families. As one of the psychiatrists took the podium, she said, "Before I begin my lecture, I have something to say to Francine Christophe." She reached into her pocket and pulled out a piece of chocolate and gave it to her, saying, "I am that baby."

The gospel is something you can give away and yet not lose it yourself. Why would we not do that?
