I Want You to Know that I Care

I don't recall a time when I have heard so much distressing news about deaths and serious health struggles within our family members here at Woodland Oaks. Seems like that when it rains sometimes it floods, doesn't it?

We are reminded at times like this of how wonderful it is to be a part of a family who genuinely care for each other. "When one part [of the body] suffers, every part suffers with it . . ."

I know that when you are part of a family as large as we are, it's not really possible to have an intimate relationship with every family member. And when we hear of someone we don't know very well who is having a struggle or has suffered a loss, we tend to not reach out to them thinking, "It won't mean much to them because we don't know each other very well, and I wouldn't know what to say."

Have you ever been in "their shoes" . . . when you were the one struggling or grieving over a loss? Can you not remember that unexpected call/message/note from someone you didn't know well? Sometimes it's that unexpected contact that touches you most. You probably won't remember what they said but you will remember that they cared enough to contact you.

The thing we most need in a time of pain and distress is simply to know that someone cares. They will never know if you don't take the time to say, "I just want you to know that I care and I'm praying for you." That's all you have to say.
