The greatest thing you can do for yourself is to make it your life’s goal to learn everything you can know about God. The reason is—because the more you know about God, the more you will trust Him. And every time your actions prove that you trust God, He smiles. He’s pleased. Faith pleases God. In fact, without faith it is impossible to please Him. That’s the one thing He wants from you—to trust Him . . . in everything.

The Bible has some profound statements about faith. Then we rest peacefully in this secure knowledge— “ . . . everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.”
