#### PRINCIPLES AND OPINIONS

We would all likely agree with the saying "If it ain't broke, don't fix it." But the problem is, we can't always agree about whether it's "broke" or not. I think that's the problem with principles. They can be applied in extremely different ways.

I find it intriguing that God chose to leave us with principles (rather than laws) to guide us in many areas. How we choose to apply principles reveals much about our motives. I'm convinced that this is exactly the point that Paul is making to the divided church in Corinth when he writes, "No doubt there have to be differences among you to show which of you have God's approval." (I Corinthians 11:19).

Principles are only effective to guide mature folks. Children abuse principles. Children constantly look for "loop-holes" - ways to avoid the obvious application. Yet God left a considerable portion of our lives to be guided by principles. The Greek word translated "differences" in the verse above means "divisions which occur from strong-willed opinions." Our English word heresy comes from this word. Those who are willing to divide the Lord's church over their strong-willed opinions are heretics and do not have God's approval.

I believe Romans 14 is the most powerful antidote against division in the entire Bible. It is all about how to handle your opinions . . . AND, how to deal with the opinions of others. I make a practice of preaching from this chapter at least once per year. It teaches us how to maintain unity in spite of diversity. Understanding the principles contained in this chapter enables a church to be able to identify potentially divisive issues which inevitably arise in congregations. Then it teaches us how to handle them.

Paul's conclusion to this chapter contains 2 statements which reveal whether you are a spiritual child or a spiritual adult:

- 1. "So whatever you believe about these things keep between yourself and God. "
- Can you have a strong opinion about something without imposing it on others?
- 2. "Blessed is the man who does not condemn himself by what he approves."
- Your opinion has the potential of causing you [and others] to lose your soul.
