I Have a Question

I often remind myself (and sometimes you) that we should not allow the fact that we don't have the answers to every question regarding a particular topic to overly upset us. Some topics/subjects are so big that we cannot plumb their depths. Besides, if we were to get our current set of questions answered, that would immediately lead to a new set of questions. We will die with questions.

Along that same line, we need to realize that our inability to understand and explain all the details of a particular subject, or answer everyone's questions about it, does not disprove it. Critics often display an air of superiority because they can ask questions they consider unanswerable.

An example of just such arrogance was when the Sadducees (who scoffed at the idea of the resurrection) desperately wanted to discredit Jesus. They approached him publicly so that everyone could witness their superiority and posed their "unanswerable" question regarding a hypothetical situation where each of seven brothers died after they had married the same woman. You can sense their smugness as they deliver their "knockout punch."—*"Now then, at the resurrection, whose wife will she be . . . since all of them were married to her?"*

This question had served them and their false teaching well . . . likely for generations. Jesus burned their straw man to the ground. They were publically humiliated. Their arrogance was unmasked. He had the answer to their unanswerable question. I suspect that will be a common occurrence when we all meet Jesus.

Don't be intimidated by someone who asks questions you can't answer to their satisfaction. We have limited information. And I don't even understand all the information that is available on any given topic. But that doesn't mean that there is no answer and it doesn't mean that what you believe is not true.
