### Taking A Bad Call

I’ve always wondered why someone would want to be a referee in a basketball game. There is so much going on at every moment of a game that you simply cannot be aware of all that’s happening. And to complicate the matter further, basketball has become a contact sport. It wasn’t originally designed that way.

With so much pushing and leaning and grabbing going on constantly, there will be fouls missed by the referees. And there will be some fouls called that will be unfair.

One of the things that interests me most is to observe how individual players react when they get (what they believe to be) a “bad call.” Some players become so angry and put on such a display that it affects their playing ability; others keep their cool and continue to focus on their job, showing little emotion.

Sometimes in life we all get “bad calls.” Something totally unfair happens to us. Job said, “Yet man is born to trouble as surely as sparks fly upward.” (Job 5:7). Bad things are going to happen in all our lives. We can allow those things to derail our entire life if we choose. We can become angry and spend the rest of our lives complaining and depressed or we can decide to put it behind us and move on.

I really do want to be one of the ones who can “take a licking and keep on ticking.” (Some of you will recognize an old Timex watch slogan ☺). Successful people do that.

In order to be that kind of person, you must 1) want to be that kind of person and you must 2) mentally prepare yourself to respond that way before it happens.

We do have a choice. We can’t control everything that happens to us . . . and sometimes it will be unfair, but we can control our response. Can you take a bad call?
