That's His Truth

I love reading Proverbs.

"The first to present his case seems right, till another comes forward and questions him." - Proverbs 18:17

I hate to admit that I've become a skeptic; maybe even a borderline cynic. I hate it. Nobody likes a cynic! But I'm like Adam when God asked him if he had eaten from "... the tree I told you not to eat from?" He had an excuse. "The woman you put here with me . . .'it's her fault!"

My excuse is based on how many times I've been embarrassed because I assumed that someone had told me the truth and I acted on it. Turned out it wasn't exactly true . . . or at least some part of the truth had been conveniently omitted.

I think that's likely what's behind this despicable phrase that has become so popular today - "That's his/her truth!" You hear it everywhere. Translation: "It's a lie." People used to say, "That's his/her **story**!" Translation: "It may or may not be true." But the popular perception of truth has decayed to the point that everyone now has his or her **own truth**. And everyone's truth is equally valid - even if it is an obviously fabricated lie. If the lie promotes an agenda that's popular enough, you may be awarded a Nobel Prize. It has happened.

Truth has been bent, fabricated, twisted and tortured from Adam till now. Hans Christin Andersen wrote a little fairy tale about it in 1837. He titled it "The Emperor's New Clothes." If you haven't read it for yourself, you should. Everyone should. You won't forget it.

The value that we place on truth may be the most accurate measure of our morality.
