What Happened to Repentance?

Politicians have learned that if you will simply "ride it out" long enough, it will go away. Another crisis will come along that will put the focus somewhere else and it all goes away. Justice is often controlled by political climate.

Not so with God. He doesn't turn a blind eye to sin. It doesn't fade away because he becomes distracted. Time and circumstance have no affect on God's righteousness and justice. That means, among other things, that we cannot deliberately decide that we want to ignore God's teaching and reap no consequences.

That's John's message in I John 1:

His premise is "God is light; in him there is no darkness at all." He then tells us what that means to us and our relationship to him:

There is some darkness in our lives. Every single one of us has sinned. That darkness (sin) has broken our relationship with him because "in him there is no darkness at all." Time will not erase it. God doesn't forget it and he does not ignore it. Every sin will be punished with full justice – separation from God.

God, because of his incomprehensible love, has provided a way for justice to be served and our relationship to him to be restored. Our part of that restoration process requires us to "confess our sins" (v.9). To repent. To determine that we no longer willingly have any part in darkness (sin).

I'm not sure what happened to repentance and confession. They have all but disappeared! We don't want anyone to be embarrassed, so we just "ride it out" - assuming it will go away. It won't. John says that we are deceiving ourselves (v.8).

Listen carefully to this fearsome warning – "If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgement and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God." - Heb. 10:26-27
