"Thank God for the Fleas"

There is a story in Corrie Ten Boom's book <u>The Hiding Place</u> that illustrates that if you are looking for something for which to be grateful, you can find it . . . regardless of your circumstance.

Corrie and her sister Betsie had been found guilty of hiding Jews in their home in Holland. Now they were incarcerated in the most horrid conditions imaginable – Ravensbrück concentration camp north of Berlin. One hundred thirty thousand women passed through this camp. A small percent survived.

At one point, the two sisters were re-assigned to different barracks – even worse than their last. The barracks were built to hold four hundred; it currently housed fourteen hundred. They quickly learned that it was infested with fleas!

Amazingly, they had managed to conceal a small Bible. They read together each evening and prayed. Their "study group" grew quickly to the point that it had to be divided so that everyone could hear the readings.

On one occasion, following the reading in First Thessalonians, the women were trying to put into practice the admonition ". . . give thanks in all circumstances." Corrie heard Betsie pray, "Thank you Lord for the fleas." She thought to herself, "Even God can't make me thankful for these wretched fleas!"

Some days later it was made obvious that the reason they were able to have their Bible studies without interference from the guards was because the guards refused to enter their barracks because it was so infested with fleas! Corrie then prayed, "Thank you Lord for the fleas."

"Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." – I Thessalonians 5:16-17.
