Jesus had a vivid imagination, didn't he? He used it to illustrate his teaching. Camels going through the eyes of needles. Wooden beams in your eyes. Swallowing a camel. They're hyperboles. Deliberate exaggerations to make a point. It helps you remember and apply the lesson. Go back and see if you can recall the lesson associated with each hyperbole above.

Each of these teach a principle. The purpose of a principle is to enable us to have a standard for making wise judgements and decisions in our life. Let's consider an application of the "swallowing a camel" principle:

In case there may be some who haven't identified one of the camel issues (vital, essential matters) on which we need to focus - it is the heinous attempts to pass legislation permitting the murder of children throughout the entire pregnancy period into the birth process.

That's a camel issue!

- Camel going through the eye of a needle - difficulty of a rich man to enter the kingdom.

– Log in a person's eye – making hypocritical, harsh judgements of others.

– Swallowing a camel – focusing on less important matters while ignoring vital, essential matters.

Jesus taught in this context that there are some matters that are more important than other matters. I would suggest that all matters have some degree of importance. But there are some matters that should be of utmost importance to every human - especially Christians. There are some "gnat matters" and some "camel matters;" some "beam matters" and some "speck matters."

There are many hot-button matters/issues that are currently dividing our country. It is really important that we as Christians do not allow ourselves to focus on the gnats and swallow the camel.
