**Not "of" the World**

I remember teaching a class on parenting several years ago in which I handed out a questionnaire. One of the questions asked, "Do you think you are doing a better job of parenting than your parents did?" I honestly didn't know what response I would get from that question. The consensus was overwhelmingly "Yes, I do think I'm doing a better job."

Since that time, I've often wondered if their parents thought the same thing. I suspect they did.

I think about the contrasting environments in which the last few generations reared their families. Each generation has had its peculiar challenges. Children reared during the Great Depression had a significantly different environment than their children did. The emphasis of the 60's was different than anything ever experienced in this country before. But was it any more radical than what we are experiencing in today's society? And what in the world will tomorrow bring?

I'm pretty sure that there has never been a world culture that was conducive to rearing godly children. True Christianity has always been counter-culture. That's why the statement ". . . don't you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God?" (James 4:4) is true for every generation.

I sincerely hope that my children ARE doing a better job of parenting their children than I did. They will have a harder job than I did because it seems that each generation builds on the sins of the last generation—at least as far as society is concerned.

That's why a strong, loving church is so vital to families. We Christians are not products of the world's culture. We live and think and act entirely differently than the world does. Don't we?
