A New Chapter Begins

Nehemiah's chronicle of the story of the rebuilding of the city walls of Jerusalem following the return from 20 years of captivity is one of the great Biblical stories. It's a story of the necessity of focused leadership. It's a study in motivation. It teaches us how to handle strong opposition and overcome discouragement. We learn about the necessity of a vision.

The single phrase that, to me, captures the beauty of this story is Nehemiah 4:6, ". . . for the people worked with all their heart." Don't you love that?

This phrase has been going through my mind daily for the last couple of weeks. It has been a beehive of activity around here as we complete our new building and make the transition. So many have volunteered for whatever needs doing. A week's worth of work gets done in 30 minutes by making an announcement that we need some volunteers after Wednesday evening Bible classes. When people "work with all their heart" it's encouraging. How can you not be encouraged when even the young children are carrying song books to the new auditorium?

Six hundred ninety six. That's Sunday morning's attendance. The Lord blesses those who serve him with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. And this is not the end. It's a new beginning.

"So the wall was completed . . . in fifty-two days. When all our enemies heard about this, all the surrounding nations were afraid . . . because they realized that this work had been done with the help of our God."
