Don't Miss the Turn

We've all had the experience of driving somewhere and becoming occupied with something, or simply not paying attention, and we miss a sign informing us of a turn we were supposed to make. We end up making an unintended detour. We might, because of our neglect, end up somewhere we don't want to be.

Years ago, I was in New Orleans and I missed my turn, so I got off at the next exit and began trying to make my way back to my intended route. It soon became obvious that I was in an area where I didn't want to be. I went only a few blocks when a policeman pulled me over with flashing lights and asked, "What are you doing here?" I told him what had happened and where I was trying to go. He instructed me to "Lock your doors, and follow me. We won't stop at any red lights." He took me back to my intended route.

In our life, we know where we want to go, but we have to follow the map (or GPS). We must pay close attention because there are lots of signs that say, "This way to heaven" but the road we're looking for is really narrow. The entrance is surrounded by billboards that are designed to deceive you. If you're following the crowd, you'll make a wrong turn and it will lead you somewhere you don't want to be.

Ephesians 5:15 admonishes us to "... be very careful that you walk accurately ..." As I look back over my life, it is more obvious than ever to me how important it is that you recognize the signs – sometimes opportunities; sometimes warnings – and that you turn when they tell you to turn. If you allow yourself to become distracted, preoccupied, or you become curious about where your current road leads, you'll miss your turn. And you won't like where you'll end up.
