No Hope . . . Little Hope . . . False Hope

I recently received an email from someone in my past . . . my distant past. In fact, I was 22 years old. He was an "older" preacher . . . probably 45! It was my first year of full-time ministry. Of course the first opportunity I had to teach a class, I taught Romans. (As Gomer Pyle used to say, "Surprise, Surprise!") To add additional drama, it was a ladies' class.

This preacher heard from one of the sweet sisters in the class that I was teaching "faith only." He went to the elders and the elders "called me in." My first trial by fire. Trust me, I've had others since. I felt like a chicken in a fox den. As they began to inform me of the purpose of the meeting, my life flashed before my eyes. I was about to be fired before I ever got off the ground!

They told me I had to stop teaching what I was teaching and move on to another topic. I told them I couldn't stop teaching what I was teaching (namely, that righteousness is imputed to us as a gift apart from law and we receive it through faith)!

In my desperation to save my skin, I proposed that the elders, this preacher and I study these principles together two nights per week for as long as it might take to try to resolve their concern. Suffice it to say, I stayed another eight years. However, shortly after that, the preacher and I lost contact . . . until recently.

He's now in his 80's. His wife has died. He's in a nursing home. He emailed me with a touching request. He said he had kept up with me over the years and recently ran across something I had written about Romans. (I'm still where I started!) He asked me if I could send him something that would help him understand the "process I went through" to arrive at the point of assurance that I have.

This is a classic illustration of why I decided to be a preacher . . . and why I'm still preaching. There are so many of my brothers and sisters who, in spite of saying otherwise, have so little hope. And there are so many other sincere religious folks who have a false hope. The same exact truth answers both dilemmas! That truth is found in Romans chapters 1-8!

He will be found by those who earnestly seek Him!
