DISCONTENTED IN A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT

One of the serendipities of teaching is that when you teach, you never know what you might say that will really be meaningful and helpful to someone. Sometimes it may not be exactly the topic of your class; it may be the *way you say* something. Or it may be a phrase you use that really turns someone's light on. That recently happened to me.

I was in Matt Fitzgerald's class at Family Camp. His lesson was based on the parable of [what we call] the prodigal son. Although he focused primarily on the older son who was jealous and angry at his father's loving response when his brother returned, Matt made a statement, almost as an aside, that really struck home with me.

Talking about the younger brother's desire to leave home he said, "If you are uncomfortable in a healthy environment, something is wrong with you!"

Click. A light came on. That's exactly right. That has so many life applications. How many young people are critical of everything about their parents and everything about their own life and they can't wait to "get out of here." Our girls were sick of having roast, potatoes and carrots EVERY Sunday . . . until they left home. Guess what they begged for when they came back!

Or how about a marriage? One spouse becomes discontent (for whatever reason) and suddenly everything is terrible. They begin to figure out how to "get out of here!"

Or how about folks who are constantly critical of their church? Once they become dissatisfied (for whatever reason) they begin to look for things to criticize.

No home is perfect. No spouse is perfect. No church is perfect. And guess what—there's one more line—go look in the mirror.
